

Nspired Cross Word

Student Activity

Introduction

The purpose of this activity is to become more familiar with the menus within the TI-Nspire CX CAS. Clues for the crossword refer to the application and menu location where the answer can be found. You must look at the number of characters available for the answer and compare this with the commands available within the specified menu.

Example 1

Clue: Calculator > Probability > Random

The first part of the clue identifies the application:

Calculator

The second part of the clue is the first menu selection:

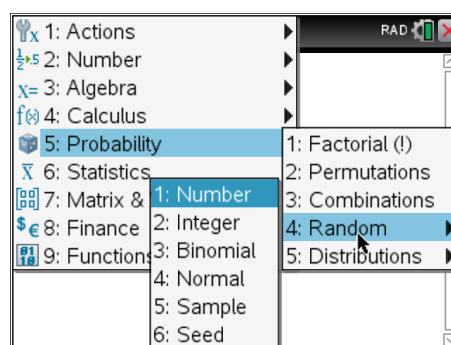
Probability

The third part of the clue is the second menu selection:

Random

Suppose the crossword requires a 6 letter word, you would therefore have three options: Number, Normal or Sample.

You would therefore need to know more information about some of the other letters in the puzzle before answering this question.



Example 2

Clue: Geometry > Construction [& 5 Across]

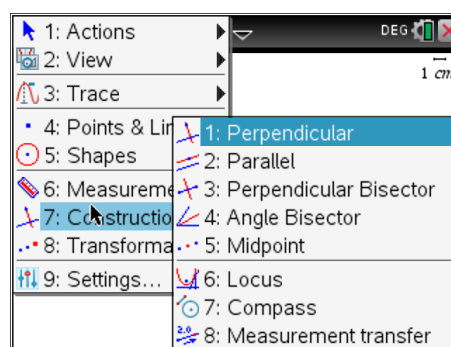
The first part of the clue identifies the application:

Geometry

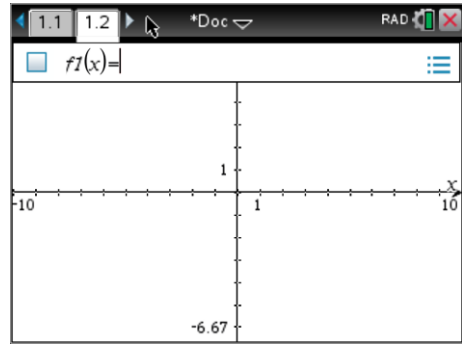
The second part of the clue is the first menu selection:

Construction

The third part of the clue means the required menu selection contains more than one word. In this case one of the words is also cited for '5 Across'. In this example the answer could be: Perpendicular Bisector, Angle Bisector or Measurement transfer. The number of available letters will help verify which answer is correct and which word goes for which clue.

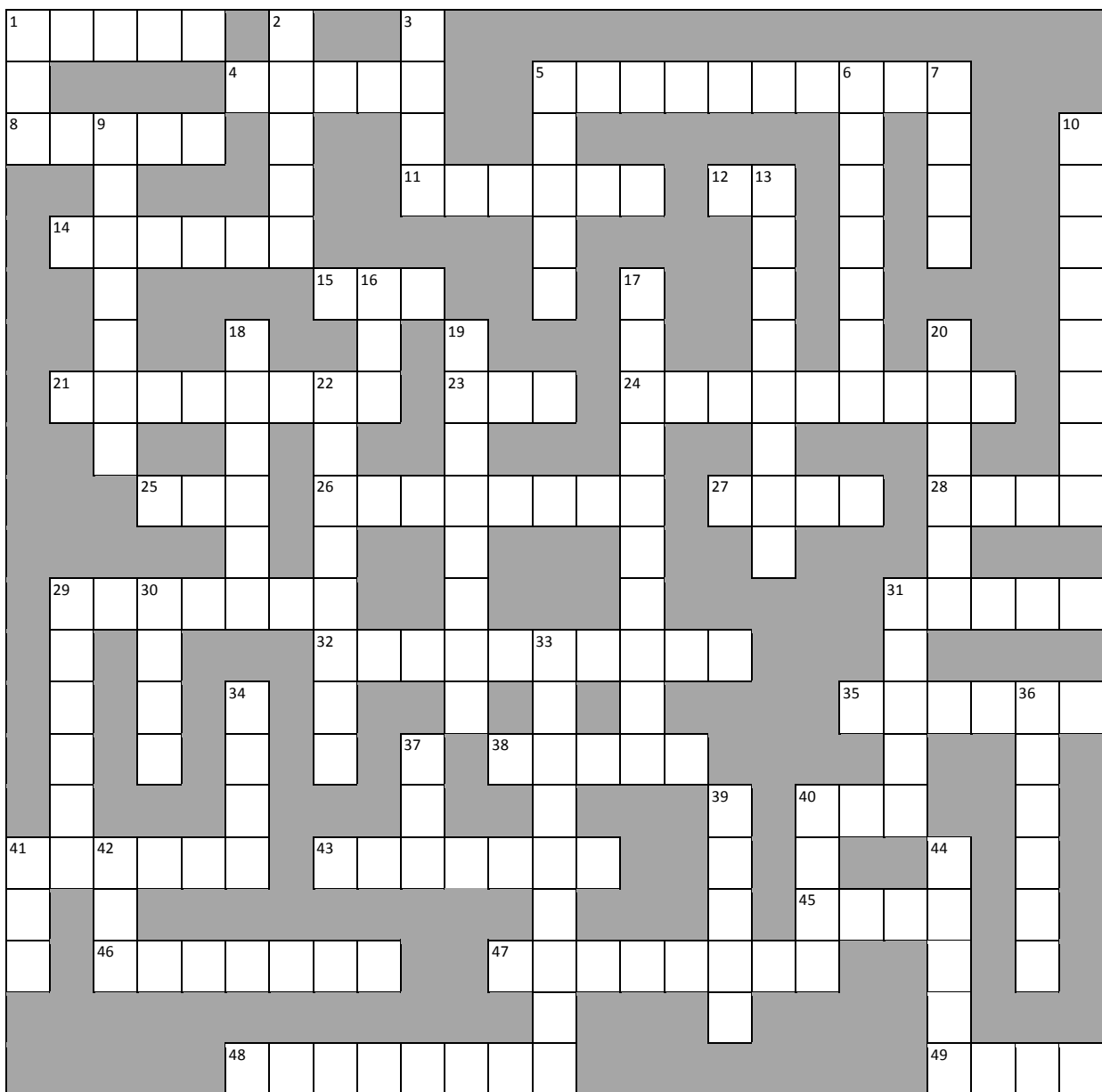


Start a new TI-Nspire document and insert a Calculator Application. Press **CTRL + I** and insert a Graphs application, notice that the tab now shows 1.2, this refers to "Problem 1" and "Page 2". This activity refers to the Calculator, Graphs, Notes and Lists and Spreadsheet applications, only one copy of each is required. The menu in each application is different, referring to functionality specific to the application.



Navigation:

- Ctrl + Right = Next Page
- Ctrl + Left = Previous Page
- Ctrl + Up = Document View (Select desired application)
- Press [ESC] to progressively retreat from menu selections
- Use number keys to quickly access menu item number
